
PC3K Import/Export Tutorial

In order to have both the old and new versions of PC3K on your computer, you'll need to do one of the following:

- A. Install the new version of PC3K in a different directory from the old version. For example, if the old version was in "C:\PC3K", the new version could be installed in "C:\PC3K_11" (or whatever).
- B. Before installing the new version, rename the old directory (e.g. "C:\PC3K_OLD").
- C. Before installing the new version, rename the old program (e.g. rename "PC3K.EXE" to "PC3K_OLD.EXE").

Any of the above methods should work.

To export from an older version of PC3K:

1. Run the older version of PC3K.
2. Load your data file (e.g. "panel.dat").
3. From the main screen's "File" menu, select "Import / Export ...".
4. Select the filename you'd like to use. By default this is the name of the data file,
with a "txt" extension (e.g. "panel.txt").
5. Click the "Export" button.
6. When the operation is complete, PC3K will tell you it's done. Click "OK", then "OK" again, then exit PC3K.

To import the data into the current version of PC3K:

1. Run the current version of PC3K.
2. From the main screen's "File" menu, select "Import / Export ...".
3. Select the file (e.g. "panel.txt").
4. Click the "Import" button.
5. When the operation is complete, PC3K will tell you it's done. Click "OK", then "OK" again.
6. Save the data file -- from the main screen's "File" menu, select "Save As..." and pick a filename
(e.g. "newpanel.dat") and click "OK".

Once you've converted all your old data files, and verified that they are correct, you may delete the old version of PC3K.
